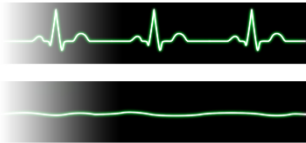
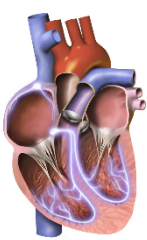

This includes caring for a casualty suffering from lack of oxygen, resuscitation of a non-breathing casualty and therapy for a breathing casualty.

- adult and infant resuscitation manikins in line with ARC guidelines for the purpose of assessment of CPR procedures
- airway model suitable for insertion of an oropharyngeal airway
- AED training device
- bag-valve-mask
- oropharyngeal airway adjunct
- oxygen resuscitation system with oxygen cylinder
- selection of oxygen masks with tubing; nasal cannula, therapy mask, resuscitation mask with oxygen port
- suction device
- workplace injury, trauma and/or illness record, or other appropriate workplace incident report forms for written reports
